## PLAY CAMP (Half Day)

Weeks 1-6 (June 26 - August 4), Ages 4-5

Our youngest campers get to experience a fun and playful week. Campers participate in gym games, arts & crafts, creative construction, outdoor play, and even baking under the supervision of our qualified and experienced camp counsellors. Please note: half day students do not go on field trips.

## MULTISPORTS

Weeks 1 (June 26 - 30), & 4 (July 17 - 21), Ages 4 - 12

Let the games begin! During multi-sport weeks, our campers will transform into sport superstars! Come and join the fun as our campers learn the fundamental skills in a variety of sports and athletic activities to be the best young athletes they can be. Multi-sports will focus on skill development, sportsmanship, fair play, and team work in a variety of sports such as floor hockey, basketball, kickball, badminton, flag football, soccer, table tennis, and rock climbing among others.

## SCIENCE BONANZA

Week 2 (July 4-7), Ages 4-12

Discover, experiment, and problem solve, as we explore all things that make up our universe. Our science specialists will be your guide as you take part in hands-on experiments, explorations, and much more.
